Bachelor Degree of Cardiovascular Technology (BCVT)

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Cardiovascular Technician assists cardiologists with invasive and noninvasive diagnostic and therapeutic interventional procedures. Catheterization involves inserting a small tube, known as catheter, into a patient's blood vessel and then into the heart. The procedure is done to determine whether the patient has a blood vessel blockage or heart disease. The procedure also involves balloon angioplasty, valvoplasy, closure of congenital defects, pacemaker implantation, vascular diagnosis and interventions etc.

Cardiovascular technician prepare patients for invasive heart procedures, monitor the patients' blood pressure and heart rate with ECG equipment, notify the cardiologist immediately of any changes in the patients' condition as well as assist the cardiologist during the procedures. Moreover, they can perform noninvasive diagnostic procedures like echocardiography, Holter and tread mill exercise testing under supervision

It goes without saying that cardiovascular technician hold an important role in the diagnostic and interventional procedures in cardiology. There is increasing need for these personnel as the number of cardiac centers and investigative facilities is increasing in the state by leaps and bounds.

Unlike most other disciplines in medicine where these technicians help the doctors in diagnostic procedures only, cardiovascular technician assists in invasive procedures and meet with life and death situations. So, they have to be trained more rigorously and need to be more mature in their approach, because mistakes may cost lives. Hence the course has to be at least 3 years with a year of internship. The course has to be a bachelor degree course.

- **1.2 Objective:** To train the student to assist the cardiologist in invasive or non-invasive cardiac laboratory, in performing routine cardiac investigations and interventional procedures.
- **1.3 Scope:** After successful completion of the course, the person can be allowed to perform noninvasive procedures like echocardiography, treadmill and Holter testing under supervision of cardiologist and assist the cardiologist in cardiac catheterization Laboratory.
- **1.4** The four-year BCVT course at our college is provisionally affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), Thrissur. The same university is authorized to conducts the examinations and grants the certificate. In addition, students attending BCVT course are professionally trained in Lisie Hospital.

1.5 This prospectus contains rules and conditions of Admission to BCVT course for the Academic year 2020-2021 in the above said institution. This prospectus is subject to modification /deletion as may be deemed necessary by the said institution and also subject to further orders if any passed by courts of law.

2. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

2.1 NATIONALITY

Only Indian citizens are eligible for admission to professional courses unless otherwise notified

2.2 ACADEMIC:

- a) Candidate should have passed Higher Secondary examination conducted by Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or examination equivalent there to as approved by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur.
- b) Should have 50% marks in Biology separately and should have 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together at the qualifying examination
- c) Rounding off of the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is not permitted

d) Candidates who have passed their qualifying examinations from the states other than Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalence of qualifying examination

2.3. AGE:

The applicant should have completed 17 years of age as on 31-12-2020.

4. PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION

4.1 Selection will be based on the rank list prepared on the basis of marks obtained in **Physics**, **Chemistry and Biology put together** at qualifying examination

In case of a tie in the total marks computed for ranking, candidates with higher marks obtained in Biology will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the candidate with higher marks obtained in Chemistry will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the candidate with higher marks obtained in Physics will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the percentage of total marks for the qualifying examination and then the percentage of marks in English in the qualifying examination will be considered for breaking the tie. Even after this, if tie remains, the age of the candidate will be taken into account and the older will be placed higher in ranking than the younger. If the tie still persists, the alphabetical order of the names of the candidates in English will be taken into account (eg. 'A' has a higher priority than 'B' and soon)

- **4.2** Furnishing false information or particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course. In addition, it will invite the relevant provisions of the criminal law of the land.
- **4.3** After scrutiny of applications, merit list of the different categories will be published in the website of LMEI www.limen.in and in the notice boards of the college. Selection will be strictly in the order of merit. Selected candidates will be intimated through email but are advised to refer college notice boards and appear for the interview and final selection without fail.

5. ADMISSION

- **5.1** For genuine reasons, principal will have the right to deny admission to any candidate even if otherwise eligible.
- **5.2** No marks will be allotted for interview.
- **5.3** Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the college after paying the admission fee, tuition fee, Caution Deposit etc, failing which the offer of admission will be cancelled. Tuition & special fee should be paid at the time of admission.

6.1 Refund of fees

After closure of admissions, the seat if vacated cannot be filled up. Such seats will go vacant for the entire duration of the course. Those who leave the course after commencement of classes, but before closure of admissions, tuition fees will be refunded provided the institution could fill up the vacancy.
